What You Need

What You Say

Encourage the children to feed the dolls or stuffed animals with

Baby dolls or stuffed animals; plastic bowls; spoons; and food

Before the Activity: "We have some very hungry babies/animals!" (Point.)

During the Activity: "Let's work together to feed them! We have bowls, spoons, and food."

After the Activity: "Great job! You fed the babies/animals! In our story, God had a plan for Joseph to help feed a lot of people. What did Joseph save up to help feed the people? (Pause.) Yes. Joseph saved the grain.

God had a plan for Joseph to do something good—share food with others. It was a very good plan! Tell me, Who has a plan for you? God has a plan for me."
